PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

INTRODUCTION

The Erie Western Pennsylvania Port Authority (the "Port Authority") owns and operates parking lots on its properties. It is important in order to preserve the condition of the parking lot and Port property and facilities that individuals using the parking lots comply with the following rules and regulations.

PARKING RULES

Parking in parking lots owned by the Port Authority is permitted for individuals attending Port Authority events or for access to Port Authority facilities in accordance with applicable signage. All vehicles shall be parked in designated spots, typically designated with parking space painted lines. Overnight parking is prohibited.

TOWING

Vehicles parked in unauthorized areas may be towed at the discretion of the Port Authority. Vehicle owners shall pay all towing expenses and comply with all requirements of the Port Authority towing contractor prior to having their vehicle returned.

LAW

These Rules and Regulations are adopted and shall comply with applicable sections of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, including 75 Pa.C.S. § 3353(b)(2) and 3354 (d)(4), regulations found at 67 Pa. Code § 212.115, the City of Erie Parking Ordinance and all other applicable laws and regulations.
