ERIE-WESTERN PENNSYLVANIA PORT AUTHORITY
EAST DOBBINS SOUTH DOCKWALL REPLACEMENT

The Erie-Western Pennsylvania Port Authority (Port Authority) requests bids for the East Dobbins South Dockwall Replacement (Contract No. 12510-2025-01). The work includes the replacement and improvement of the existing dockwall, totaling approximately 520 linear feet, located east of State Street along the north side of the East Canal Basin adjacent to Presque Isle Bay within the City of Erie. The replacement dockwall will be constructed utilizing anchored steel sheet piles embedded and pinned into the underlying bedrock. The work will also include over 680 linear feet of new concrete walkway construction, fabricated steel railings, backfill placement and grading, etc. A pre-bid conference will be held at the office of the Port Authority located at 1 Holland Street, Erie, PA 16507 at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 5, 2025, attendance is recommended. Bids must be submitted to the Port Authority offices located at 1 Holland Street, Erie, PA 16507 by 2:00 p.m. on Friday, February 21, 2025, at which time the bids will be opened and read publicly. A sixty-day bid hold period applies, and ten percent bid security is required. The successful Bidder/Contractor shall be required to furnish performance and payment bonds, each in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price.
